# 2) MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

The minutes were approved as a true record.

# 3) MATTERS ARISING

a) The work on the kitchen has been completed and J. Smith as been paid. 20% VAT was payable on the total. The dishwasher was £1500, the fire curtain £3300. An extra £736 was taken out of Hall funds to pay for new cupboard doors, two replacement panes of glass in the kitchen window and a fire safety light in the switchboard room. As a condition of the award, AM is to write an article, including photos, for the Oban Times.

b) FG advised that the update of the Constitution is in progress and a Code of Conduct , approved by the committee, is to be included.

c) Regarding the damage caused during a pre-Christmas event, AM reported that no reply has been received to letters written to the person who organised the party, and no recompense for damages. Estimated cost is £213. The police are looking into the matter.

d) DS has contacted the Council to ask about a blue recycling bin for the Hall car-park. As this would cost £63.84 annually to have emptied, in addition to the £234.00 already being paid for the green bin, it was decided not to have one.

## 4) CARETAKER'S REPORT

a) The damaged door to the Ladies' cloakroom has been replaced, and the mirror in the Gents. The panel in the main hall door still needs to be replaced, in wood if necessary, also the stairwell light fitting.

b) The electrician reported that a faulty trip switch needs to be replaced on the switchboard panel, and also the fire alarm switches which are corroded. These are linked to the fire curtain circuit.

c) Some glass may need to be replaced in the entrance lobby.

d) The spring cleaning went well. Thanks to AM, MM, FG, LF, Caroline, Olga, Peter and Dorothy. Elspeth and Peter helped to paint the kitchen and DS painted the skirting boards in the main hall. CG is to shampoo the carpets.

### 5) TREASURER'S REPORT

- a) The main account stands at £2604, with £115 cash in hand.
- b) The 100 Club account stands at £1092.

### 6) FUND RAISING
