2) MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

3) MATTERS ARISING

a) The defibrillator is to be mounted near the entrance door to the Hall.

b) A cheque for £605.00 has been received from the Grab Trust for the Beach Clean.

c) The water heater and tank, that supplies the kitchen hot water, has to be completely replaced, as the

damaged part is no longer manufactured. Jim Smith is to carry out the fitting.

d) Jim Smith has repaired the faulty trip switch on the switchboard panel.

4) CARETAKER'S REPORT

a) In the Ladies' cloakroom, the middle toilet is not flushing properly and the middle washbasin is very slow to drain. The lavatory seat in the Gents' is loose. CG is to look at these.

b) Liquid soap is to be used in the cloakrooms instead of small tablets, as these can block the waste pipes from the washbasins.
